Dr Sanjay Kotte, Urologist and Kidney transplant surgeon at Sparsh Urology and Kidney Hospital, Dhantoli, Maharashtra, removed a 154 cm (5 ft 0.6 in.) long soft electric wire from the urinary bladder of a patient by percutaneous cystoscopy extraction of foreign body surgery on 28 August 2012.

Largest bone tumour removed
Dr B.K.S. Sanjay, professor and head of orthopaedic surgery, Himalayan Institute of Medicine, Dehradun, Uttarakhand, removed a malignant bone tumour (chondrosarcoma) of the right femur, weighing 16.5 kg, from 35-year-old Naresh Kumar of Haridwar, Uttarakhand, on 10 June 2002. The tumour was 45 cm (17.71 in.) in length and 30 cm (11.81 in.) in width, with a circumference of 97 cm (38.19 in.) and a volume of 14.135 cubic cm.

Largest kidney stone removed
Dr Hemendra Shah at R.G. Stone Urological Research Institute, Mumbai, Maharashtra, removed a 13 cm (5.12 in.) wide kidney stone from a patient on 18 February 2004.

Largest renal calculus removed
Dr Saraj Kumar Singh, Assistant Professor, AIIMS, Patna, Bihar, and his assisting team removed a brain tumour weighing 2.280 kg (2,280 g) from a 50-year-old male patient on 22 November 2021 at the hospital. The surgery to excise the tumour began at 12:26 p.m. and ended at 3:42 p.m., lasting 3 hrs 16 mins. The tumour measured 24 cm x 24 cm x 14 cm (9.44 in. x 9.44 in. x 5.51 in.).
